Confidence Indicators Roughly Unchanged in June

Manufacturing

Manufacturing confidence improved a few points but it remained well below long-term average.

Construction

Confidence turned down in June after an upswing in spring.

Finnish manufacturing confidence improved slightly in June. However, the confidence indicator was clearly below average. It scored -8 points (-11 in May). The long-term average is +1. Production is expected to grow only very slowly during the next few months. Order books are below their long-term average. In contrast, stocks of final goods have decreased and their level is only slightly above average.

Finnish construction confidence indicator turned down in June after a recovery one month earlier. It fell to -15 points (-10 in May) while its long-term average is -8. Confidence is thus weaker than its long-term normal. Order books are fairly small and personnel is still expected to decrease slightly.

The service sector confidence indicator improved only marginally in June. It scored +2 points, one point up from the revised figure one month earlier. The

long-term average is +13. Overall business situation of Finnish service compa-

nies has still deteriorated gradually. However, sales expectations have improved
