# **Only Minor Changes in Finnish Business Confidence**

#### Manufacturing

Manufacturing confidence stayed close to average level

Finnish manufacturing confidence was almost unchanged in January. The confidence indicator stood at +2 points (+1 in December). Production is expected to increase somewhat during the next few months. Order books stayed slightly below average. Stocks of final goods were close to normal levels.

#### Construction

Construction confidence is relatively robust

### Confidence in the Finnish construction sector improved marginally in January. The confidence indicator scored +2 points (revised figure +1 in December). Confidence is currently steadier than its long-term average (-8). Order books are still slightly below average but some workforce growth is predicted.

The service sector confidence indicator stayed stable at +16 points in January. It is slightly above its long-term average (+13). The overall business situation in

Finnish servce companies has continued to improve. Sales volumes are expected


Service sector confidence was unchanged in January

#### Retail trade


Retail trade confidence improved somewhat

#### Services Confidence Indicator


